 despite futility, unlimited endurance, pain insensitivity, constant yelling, aggression toward
 inanimate objects, running for no reason;
- Delusional, paranoid, irrational, bizarre behavior, inability to maintain attention, disorientation, disorganized thinking, incoherent speech, naked/semi-clothed

+3 Extremely Agitated

- Severe combative, violent, aggressive, agitated behavior, significant physical strength, struggle despite futility, significant endurance, pain insensitivity, constant yelling/screaming;
- 2. Displaying no signs of delirium

+2 Moderately Agitated

Moderate violent/agitated behavior, frequent yelling

+1 Restless

· Anxious or apprehensive but movements are not aggressive or vigorous

0 Alert, Oriented, Calm

-1 Drowsy

· Not fully alert, but has sustained (more than 10 seconds) awakening, with eye contact to voice

-2 Light Sedation

· Briefly (less than 10 seconds) awakens with eye contact to voice

-3 Moderate Sedation

· Any movement (but no eye contact) to voice

-4 Deep Sedation

· No response to voice, any movement to physical stimulation

-5 Unresponsive

· No response to voice or physical stimulation
