Judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Plaintiff, Mary Wolski, and against the Defendant, The City of Erie, for back pay in the amount of \$206,665.58 plus prejudgment interest in the amount of 6% per annum as stipulated by the parties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff shall be reinstated as a firefighter when the next vacancy occurs. The City of Erie shall pay the Plaintiff front pay calculated from the date of this judgment to the date of her reinstatement.
