COUNT ONE

The United States Attorney charges:

In or about December 2007, in the Southern District of
New York and elsewhere, HAYTHAM KHALIL, the defendant,
unlawfully, intentionally, and knowingly did access a computer
without authorization and did exceed authorized access, and
thereby did obtain information from a department and agency of
the United States, to wit, KHALIL, while employed as a New York
City Police Department ("NYPP") sergeant, accessed without
authorization a computer system which contained information
maintained by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, National Crime
Information Center, obtained information regarding an individual
listed on a terrorist watch list, and then disseminated that
information to a third party.
